# EUROPEAN PUBLIC HEALTH ASSOCIATION

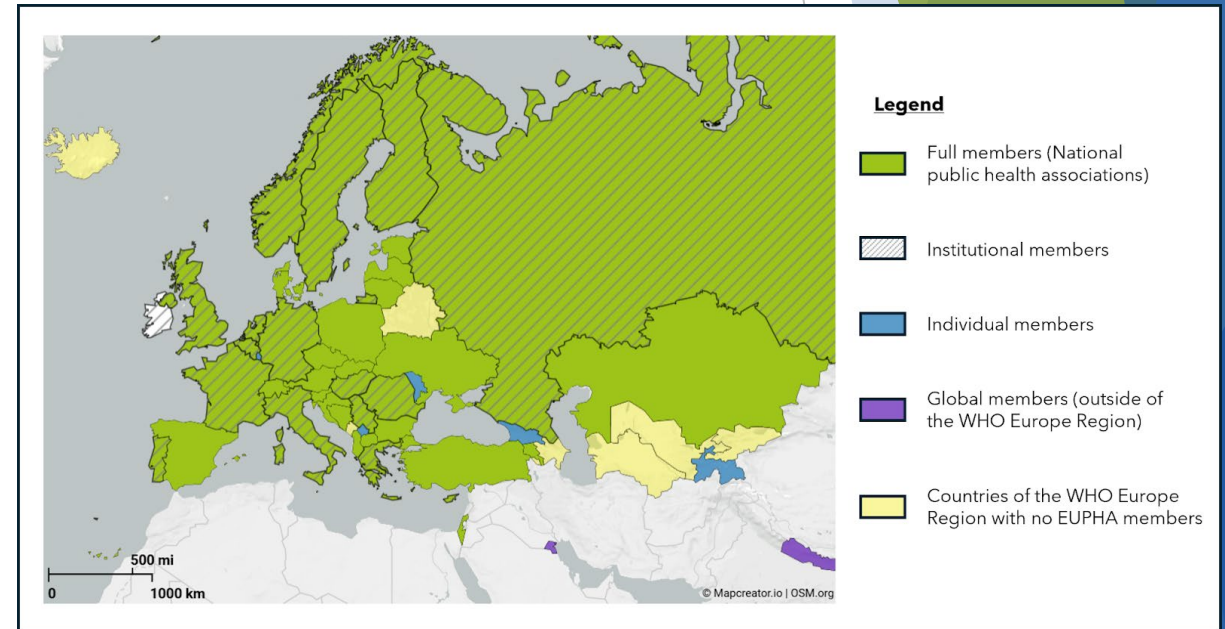
▶ EUPHA is *the umbrella organisation* of public health associations in the **European region**, with over **35 000 public health professionals** in our network.

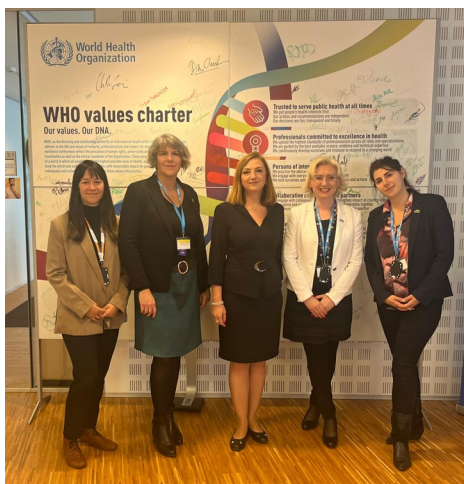
## **Working with National Institutes**
